SUBJECT: Calling Notice for NATO EOD Staff Officer Training (NATO EOD SOT) - Poland, 20 – 30 April 2026.

DATE: 21 January 2026

1. Based on the NATO/IP customers' demand for education and training in the EOD area, the NATO EOD COE delivers the **NATO EOD Staff Officer Training (NATO EOD SOT)**.
2. NATO/IP nations are invited to attend the NATO EOD SOT, which will take place at the **Military Engineering and CBRN Training Centre in Wroclaw, Poland, from 20 to 30 April 2026**.
3. The deadline for registration is **27 February 2026**. The maximum number of seats available on the course is limited to 16 students.
4. The NATO EOD SOT is designed to educate and train non-qualified EOD staff officers to achieve a basic level of proficiency IAW NATO and UN standards. EOD staff officer is able to plan, prepare, command, control and coordinate EOD operations within MN operations at Battalion and Brigade levels of command.

ANNEX A

to Calling Notice for NATO EOD SOT, 20 - 30 APR 2026

ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDANCE

1. GENERAL OVERVIEW

a) Scope:

The NATO EOD COE in Trencin, Slovakia, will deliver the NATO EOD SOT from Monday 20 April to Thursday 30 April 2026 (2 weeks). The first week will be dedicated to the EOD standards and procedures, while the second week will concentrate on practical training and exercises.

The Advanced Distributed Learning (ADL) phase is an integral part of the course. The online e-Lessons will be accessible to selected students from 16 March 2026, and each student is required to complete all e-Lessons and successfully pass a final test. Completion of this e-Learning phase must be achieved no later than 19 April 2026.

Successful completion of the ADL test is a mandatory prerequisite for course attendance.

b) Aim:

The NATO EOD SOT is designed to educate and train non-qualified EOD staff officers to achieve a basic level of proficiency IAW NATO standards. EOD staff officer is able to plan, prepare, command, control and coordinate EOD operations within multinational operations at Battalion and Brigade levels of command.

c) Target Audience:

NATO/IP nation's personnel serving or intent to serve in EOD or EOD-related positions will be accepted IAW the NATO EOD COE seats allocation policy.

1. OF-1 to OF-4 level and senior staff NCOs serving in HQs.
2. Language skills: IAW STANAG 6001, an adequate understanding of written and spoken English is expected from the course attendees. SLP 2222 is recommended as the minimum level of proficiency.

d) Performance Objectives:

1. Applies Explosive Ordnance (EO) related Risk & Threat Management.
2. Comprehend the EOD capabilities and limitations on multinational deployments.
3. Manages EOD activities in support of multinational operations.

e) Security Classification:

The Security Clearance for the course is NATO Unclassified.

f) Training Area:

The NATO EOD COE SOT will be organised and delivered at the Military Engineering and CBRN Training Center, Wroclaw, Poland.

2. EXECUTION

Attendees are expected to arrive at the Military Engineering and CBRN Training Center, 108 Obornicka Street, Wroclaw, Poland (attendee's responsibility) **NLT 07:30 on Monday, 20 April 2026.**

The Course will be finished NLT 12:00 on Thursday, 30 April 2026.

a) Registration:

Follow these steps to apply for seats on the NATO EOD SOT course:

1. Registration can only be done electronically through the EOD COE web page at the following link: <https://eodcoe.org/2.html>
2. In case of any issues, contact the EOD COE Point of Contact (Admin) by e-mail.
3. Do not begin the registration process without resolving your course financing.
4. The registration deadline is set on **27 February 2026**. Registration Forms submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.
5. All applicants will receive a confirmation or regret letter from the Admin **NLT on 6 March 2026**. It is strongly advised that no applicant starts managing arrangements before receiving confirmation of acceptance to the course!

b) In-processing:

In-processing will occur from **08:00 to 08:45 AM** on the first day of the course at the Military Engineering and CBRN Training Center, Wroclaw, Poland.

Each attendee should be in possession of:

- ID card (e.g. passport) as listed in the registration form,
- NATO Travel Order or equivalent.

c) Course fee:

A course administration fee is 160 € per attendee. The method of payment will be indicated in the Confirmation Letter. Course fees do not apply to students from the NATO EOD COE Sponsoring Nations (CZE, HUN, POL, ROU, SVK and the USA) and NATO Command Structures.

d) Dress code:

BDU for military personnel (no helmet, no weapon).

3. SERVICE SUPPORT

a) Transportation:

Transportation is each individual's responsibility.

Arrival by air/bus/train:

The recommended airport is Warsaw, Poland. To reach the city of Wroclaw, attendees can use a rental car or public transportation (bus, train).

The attendees can also find direct flights to Wroclaw, Poland.

b) Accommodation:

Arranging accommodation remains each participant's personal responsibility. Attendees must independently secure their own hotel bookings in Wroclaw.

The recommended accommodation facility is the InterHotel, (<https://interhotelwroclaw.pl/>) from which the transportation to the Military Engineering and CBRN Training Center will be organized within the whole duration of the course by the NATO EOD COE's shuttle bus.
